This approach addresses one of the central challenges facing the responsible deployment of artificial intelligence: how to expand access and efficiency without removing professional accountability, human judgment, or safeguards in high-stakes environments. Your work provides a practical example of how domain experts can guide the development and application of AI systems in ways that account for the limitations of the technology while preserving the interests and rights of the people who rely upon it.



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Your leadership of LegalPilot is particularly notable because it builds upon more than fifteen years of academic and professional experience in law. As a Candidate of Legal Sciences, Associate Professor of Constitutional and International Law, practicing international and immigration lawyer, researcher, and author, you bring substantive domain expertise to the design and implementation of technology intended for individuals navigating complex cross-border legal systems.

Your professional work across Ukrainian, Spanish, European, and international legal frameworks gives you an uncommon interdisciplinary perspective on the practical challenges involved in developing AI-supported information systems for international and displaced communities. These challenges include differences among jurisdictions, changing immigration requirements, linguistic accessibility, protection of vulnerable populations, reliability of legal information, and the need for clear boundaries between automated information and individualized professional advice.
