It is reserved for professionals whose work demonstrates sustained achievement, recognized expertise, meaningful professional contribution, and the capacity to contribute substantively to a high-trust, expert-level international environment.

Fellow Members are expected to play an active role within the network by contributing their expertise, participating in selected professional activities, engaging with other experts, and supporting high-level dialogue within their respective areas of knowledge. Fellows may be invited to contribute to roundtables, expert discussions, publications, advisory conversations, reviews, speaking engagements, or other initiatives aligned with the mission of The GRail Network.

Within the organization's expert-level environment, Fellows help shape substantive discussions, contribute perspective to developing areas of focus, and participate as members of a trusted professional community whose expertise may inform future initiatives, professional themes, and interdisciplinary conversations.

The GRail Network hereby confirms that Nataliia Fursenko has been admitted as a Fellow Member of the organization.

The review also considered Ms. Fursenko's development of the Legal Bridge Method, a practice-oriented methodology integrating legal assistance, legal education, and mechanisms for protecting the rights of migrants and forcibly displaced persons. This work reflects her broader effort to transform specialized legal knowledge into structured and scalable approaches intended to improve access to legal information and justice.

Ms. Fursenko's professional profile further includes advanced academic credentials and sustained experience as a legal scholar, university educator, researcher, and practicing lawyer. Her work spans Ukrainian, Spanish, European, and international legal frameworks, providing her with a distinctive cross-border perspective on immigration, human rights protection, legal accessibility, and the legal and ethical dimensions of emerging technologies.
